Kviteseid district is located centrally in Western Telemark. The Telemark waterways (Telemark Canal) and the Arendal waterways are distinctive features of the landscape. The majestic surrounding mountains and the landscape in general encourage a wide range of outdoor activities in winter and summer.

The district's centre, Kviteseid town (www.kviteseidbyen.no) is located halfway between the tourist areas of Vrådal (www.vraadal.com) and Morgedal (www.morgedal.no)

The district has a variety of industries based on tourism, small businesses, agriculture, trade and public service. The district has long traditions as the administrative centre of Telemark due to its central location in Western Telemark and alongside the Telemark waterways.
